I am so honored and full of enthusiasm to present you with a truly unique and magical course of study. This extensive program is designed to enable you, as an apprentice, to venture further than you have ever gone before into your own personal environment of skill and possibility. For over twenty-five years, I have shared the teachings of the Sisterhood of the Shields through my books, lectures, and trainings. But it is within this Mystery School, a school without walls, and our annual gatherings that you are able to deepen and fully experience the wonder and magic contained within these teachings.

Our four-year training is carefully and skillfully designed to support you in awakening and discovering the beauty and power within you. Each aspect is intended to move you through your own personal gateways. The School is a combination of new written material, special audio recordings I've prepared, sacred tasks, conversations with me during conference calls, working with a graduate apprentice mentor selected for you, and two five-day gatherings each year. Through this material, available only to school apprentices, your sense of self and your ability to experience the world around you will expand, and your life will become more beautiful and fulfilling.

Throughout history, many sacred teachings have been vigilantly guarded and only passed down from shaman to apprentice through one-on-one teaching, storytelling, and sacred initiations. This is the way of the Sisterhood of the Shields. In my own journey, my teachers, Agnes Whistling Elk and Ruby Plenty Chiefs, would work with me for a short time, sharing stories, having me complete a certain task or sending me off to dream, and then throw me back on my own devices and my day-to-day life. It was during these times that my deepest work was accomplished. I was able to strengthen my own dream body and understand how to hold my own energy separate from my teachers'. Our Mystery School is a "school without walls" and is intended to bring you these teachings with the same depth and intensity of the ancient mystery schools; that is what we strive for.

This work of shamanic endeavor is about traversing the timeless pathways of the universe and bringing them home to bridge the environment of magic with your 21st century life. You will have the opportunity to develop such abilities as Dreaming, Seeing, Conjuring, and Energy Dancing to understand how to use the sacred wheel to bring balance into all facets of your life. You will build your own dreaming body and be able to establish and maintain the integrity of your own energy field. It is my sincerest wish that with the guiding energy and wisdom of the Sisterhood of the Shields, as an apprentice, you will be able to accomplish this same definition of spirit and body.

A unique aspect of the Mystery School is our two annual gatherings. The first is our gathering at the sacred fires of Joshua Tree in the spring. An extraordinary celebration and time of deep and profound inner work! Since 1989, we have returned to this sacred land to dance, do personal ceremony, and share our truths with each other. Our second gathering is the Storm Eagle Training in the fall, which is the culmination of each year's work. We sit together in circle, create sacred theater, and deepen not only our skills but also our energy lines as a spiritual community.

We have entered the new millennium, and Great Spirit is not asking us, but demanding that we move to a higher level of life and consciousness. This is a time of great testing and a time of moving our light and our magnificent luminous fibers out into the world. But you need not walk your path alone. Through your work in our Mystery School, you will be surrounded by a circle of powerful and loving beings.

Always remember that you get out of life what you put into it. The education is here and available to you, but it requires your commitment to your own evolverment. And if you are familiar with my books, you understand, on a very deep level, that apprenticeship in shamanism requires dedication and a lot of hard work. As Agnes Whistling Elk has often told me, our purpose in this lifetime is to become enlightened, and yet it is the one thing we are most afraid of. The Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts and Training (LACSAT) will provide you with tools of empowerment to use in your everyday life. While you will be working at your own pace, from your own home, you will need to complete certain elements of this course in time for each of two gatherings a year, *Joshua Tree* (Spring) and *the Storm Eagle Training* (Fall).

Apprentices come into this circle of teaching for a myriad of reasons and all are welcome. As Agnes reminds us the greatest gift we can give the world is our own enlightenment. This journey will enrich your soul, bringing you a greater sense of your purpose in this life, and providing you with the opportunity to become part of a powerful, loving, and supportive community of sacred beings. And for some, this training becomes the foundation for building a spiritual practice as a shaman healer. Through our work together you have the opportunity to become a certified Spiritual Healer and an Ordained Minister with tools and skills you can use in the world.

This work is mystical and is not just a process of adding on more information, but rather a re-creating of your point of view, and re-defining of what appears real and knowable in this universe. The teaching of sacred arts is non-linear; it is, in fact, holographic. Each piece of the work reflects the totality of the teaching. Throughout this four-year program, you may revisit particular aspects of your life or your energy and experience it from a new perspective.

About our Joshua Tree Gatherings *

Our annual gathering at Joshua Tree, held in late spring, is an important milestone each School year. It is the first opportunity of each year for us to come together as a group and celebrate what we have accomplished through our studies and ceremonial work. The teachings, experiences, and work presented at the *Joshua Tree Gathering*, currently held at Ghost Ranch near Abiquiu, New Mexico, are an integral part of your year and are a requirement of the school that will support your growth. Your LACSAT tuition includes both the *Joshua Tree Gathering* plus the *School Day at Joshua Tree* designed specifically for students, mentors, and Lynn to gather together. The main *Joshua Tree Gathering* is open to all who wish to come, whether enrolled in the School or not, and can be a wonderful introduction to the teachings of the School.

About the Storm Eagle Training *

The Storm Eagle Training is a no-holds-barred, roll-up-your-sleeves, get-down-to-work session of instruction and practice, and is a requirement of the School that is included in your LACSAT tuition. Currently, the training is held in Los Angeles and runs from Wednesday through Sunday in early November. *The Storm Eagle Training* is a quickening of the work you have accomplished throughout the year. You will have an opportunity to sit in an intimate teaching circle with Lynn. You will work with advanced Graduate Apprentices and be able to share your work with your peers. It is truly a coming together of our sacred community. This process will pull in power to support you in your own personal healing and facilitate your growth as a shaman healer in the world. You will find yourself venturing further than you ever thought possible. *The Storm Eagle Training* can be attended only by those who are enrolled in the School.

Elements of the School

1. As a Student Apprentice you will work directly with a *Mentor* who will be supervised and guided by Lynn. You will need to be in regular contact with your mentor, via e-mail, telephone, letters, or face-to-face meetings, depending on what works best for you and your mentor. Your mentor will answer your questions and provide you with guidance and direction.
2. There will be audio recordings of special teachings and messages from Lynn created exclusively for Student Apprentices. There will be monthly full moon and new moon meditations. There will also be regularly scheduled conference calls with Lynn, mentors, and other students in your school year.
3. Lynn's books and tapes are part of this course of study and are available for purchase from Lynn's on-line store on her website, lynnandrews.com. Other books and materials are required for school assignments, as well.
4. The School is a 4-year course of study. There are two levels of completion: one is a Professional Certification, and the second level is for personal healing and transformation. Completion of all tasks and assignments is required to receive a Certificate of Completion and be professionally certified as a graduate of The Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts & Training. This is required for you to be fully licensed and ordained by Lynn Andrews. For your attendance and general participation in the School, you will receive a Certificate of Acknowledgment, which will entitle you to become an Earth Steward, and you will be acknowledged as such by Lynn Andrews.

You will discuss with your mentor which level of completion is appropriate for you during the course of your first year. Successful completion of either level of participation allows you to fully participate in the ongoing graduate circle through our Kindred Spirits Continuing Education Program.

Your School Tuition covers written instructions and guidelines from Lynn; conference calls with Lynn, mentors and classmates from your school year; special audio recordings exclusively for the School; a notebook to hold your study materials; individual work with your mentor; occasional School related mailings from Lynn and the Sisterhood of the Shields; tuition for the two yearly gatherings of *Joshua Tree* and *Storm Eagle*. Lodging and meals for the *School Day* at Joshua Tree and the event of *Joshua Tree* are not included. Lodging and meals for the *Storm Eagle Training* are not included. You are also responsible for all transportation costs to and from each of these events.

6. The curriculum is based on four 11-week quarters. Requests for a refund must be sent in writing and all materials received must be returned unopened. If your request is approved, it will be refunded per the time of year, and the quarter materials, you have already received and/or returned.

2010 FINANCIAL POLICIES

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

The school is designed in quarters—each quarter being 11 weeks in duration. Your study materials will be mailed to you just prior to the start of each quarter. **Tuition payment(s) must be received before the materials will be mailed to you.**

You may pay your tuition in Full, or on a Quarterly or Monthly basis. Should you choose to make quarterly or monthly payments, there will be an additional annual one time \$100 processing fee to cover bookkeeping and administration costs.

The Payment Schedule is as follows:

- 1st Quarter Payment due by January 15
- 2nd Quarter Payment due by March 15
- 3rd Quarter Payment due by June 15
- 4th Quarter Payment due by August 15

- All MONTHLY payments are due on or before the 15th of each month. Monthly payments are divided over a 10 month period, January 15th through October 15th.

If you will be mailing in checks or money orders for your payments they are due as stated above.
(All returned checks will incur a \$25 fee by L.A.P.)

If you choose to pay by credit card, your credit card payments will be processed between the 15th and 22nd of the month.

Information on the Degree Programs Offered by the Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts and Training

WHAT IS THE DEGREE PROGRAM?

Apprentices are now able to earn a Bachelors of Science (B.S.), a Masters of Science (M.S.), or a Ph.D. in Natural Health Sciences, in conjunction with the University of Natural Medicine in Santa Fe, New Mexico, through the Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts and Training (LACSAT) and the Kindred Spirits Program (KSP). The degrees are in Natural Health Sciences with a concentration in Sacred Arts and Training. The University of Natural Medicine (UNM) is a fully licensed university, which is in the process of completing the requirements needed to apply for federal accreditation. The interim accreditation status does not affect the validity of the degrees obtained from their programs; however, students may find that other academic institutions may not give full credit for course work through UNM if they desire to transfer or continue their education before UNM has gained their accreditation.

HOW DOES THE DEGREE PROGRAM WORK AND WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

Students will work with an Academic Advisor to focus their studies and develop their thesis or dissertation. All degrees require a LACSAT Certificate of Completion gained through the rigorous completion of the 4-year LACSAT program with Lynn Andrews, certified by the student's Mentor and the Academic Advisor. To pursue a degree, students must also enroll in either LACSAT or KSP. The number of required credit hours for each degree depends on the student's incoming credit from prior education (training or life experience may apply), and the status of their completed work in LACSAT or KSP; however the general requirements for each degree follow:

All Degrees require at least 15- 25 credit hours be taken from UNM

Bachelors of Science (B.S.) - Successful completion of all work within the LACSAT program (16 quarters/128 credit hours), plus 15 to 120 credit hours from UNM or another academic institution to satisfy the pre-requisites for a B.S.

Masters of Science (M.S.) - Requirements for a post-graduate student are successful completion of all work within LACSAT (16 quarters), completion of any necessary UNM core curriculum and a Thesis (15-45 credits).

Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) - Requirements for a post-graduate student are successful completion of LACSAT (16 quarters), 2 years of KSP directed study, any necessary UNM core curriculum and a doctoral dissertation to be defended before the doctoral committee (43-60 credit hours).

WHAT DOES THE DEGREE PROGRAM COST?

The University of Natural Medicine has developed diverse degree programs that offer educational choices available through independent, residential and practical training. All degrees require at least 15-25 credit hours be taken with the University of Natural Medicine. LACSAT and KSP programs are now part of this unique educational experience. Participation in LACSAT or KSP is required to participate in the degree program, and those costs are separate from the University of Natural Medicine tuition rates shown below. In addition, there is a LACSAT Degree Program registration fee of \$200.00.

Bachelor of Science: Natural Health, Sacred Arts and Training:

15 to 120 credit hours
\$75.00- \$100.00/ credit hour

Masters of Science: Natural Health, Sacred Arts and Training:

15 to 45 credit hours (Thesis is 15 credit hours)
\$75.00- \$100.00/ credit hour

Doctor of Philosophy: Natural Health, Sacred Arts and Training (beyond a Masters)

43-60 credit hours (Dissertation is 25 credit hours)
\$75.00-\$160.00/ credit hour

Please note: The fees listed above do not include application fees or other administrative fees and are in addition to the total tuition paid to the Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts and Training for the LACSAT or KSP programs. Prices for LACSAT, KSP and UNM programs may be subject to change.

CAN I RECEIVE FINANCIAL HELP TO PURSUE A DEGREE?

Though the University of Natural Medicine and Lynn Andrews Center for Sacred Arts and Training do not yet have financial aid programs, there are ways for students to research and apply for specific grants and scholarships to help finance the completion of a degree. There are many organizations, websites, and other resources that can help find the appropriate scholarship or grant which may be available to you. It is challenging to summarize all the different scholarships, since each program has unique and different qualifications and may only be available to you if you live in a specific state, are a certain age, or are working towards a specific career. However, the many scholarship programs available are worth checking out to see if any apply to your individual situation. The following resource may be helpful:

In addition to these resources, the University of Natural Medicine has a “Pay-As-You-Go” program that allows students to pay for courses as they are taken with a deposit of \$800.00.

CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR PROFESSIONALS

WORKSHOPS

The Joshua Tree Gathering and Storm Eagle Training workshops are part of the annual curriculum.

Joshua Tree Gathering: A basic concern for nurses and therapists is spiritual well being and its contribution to health. We will explore the wondrous connection of mind, body, and spirit in illness. Ceremony, meditation, role playing, representational art, group activities, spiritual allies, and energy work are integrative treatments that will be discussed, followed by a facilitated discussion on incorporating them into your practice. Joshua Tree is open to both currently enrolled students and non-students.

Storm Eagle Training: An intensive review and observed practice of integrative methods learned during the current school year, as well as an introduction and practice of work from the next school year. All students meet together for new concepts, meditation, ceremony and Q&A sessions. The focus is on integrative methods of working to obtain spiritual, emotional, and physical well being. Storm Eagle is only available to currently enrolled students.
