Spring is akin to the beginning cycle of life. It is the time when the seeds for new growth are planted. During wintertime, you hibernate and hold close to you all that you have accomplished during the previous year, and you discard what no longer serves you. Then in the spring, in the first planting of the year, you have a sense of what it is that you need to accomplish in the months ahead.

Planting seeds requires great care. You gather your seeds, or you bring forth the seeds you have saved throughout the past years, and you choose the seeds that are truly important to you. This year, across North America and indeed across the Northern Hemisphere, winter hangs on well after our celebrations of the Spring Equinox. It is as if Mother Earth is saying to us,

"Don't be so quick to dash headlong into the world. Take the time right now to fully know what is important to you. Make your decisions carefully as to what you want to discard, what you want to hold for future growth and what you want to concentrate your energy on now. That way, when you move out into the world with your magnificent acts of power, you know who you are and you know that you are speaking your own truth, living your own life, and not the life someone else says you should be living."

This is the time for you to gather your energy, for when you plant a seed, you are planting and cultivating energy so that the life force will find its way toward the light, and blossom, and become a manifested reality.

Spring is the time of the life and death prayer arrows. You place all that you want to give away to the universe into the death arrow, and you burn it symbolically, either in visualization or in actual ceremony. Then you place your acts of power -- the ten things that you are going to do in the coming year to make your act of power a reality -- into the life arrow. This life arrow you give away to the universe; plant its base in the fertile soil with its tip pointing up to the sky. This is the practice that sets you on your course for the rest of the year.

The Power Deck, Cards of Wisdom teaches that gathering is an aspect of power in the north on the Sacred Wheel. North is the home of spirit and your relationship to God, the Goddess, Great Spirit.

North is the home of the adult, a responsible, independent and balanced being. It is the home of wisdom and power.

So when you gather your seeds for your Spring planting, for your life and death prayer arrows, you turn to your relationship with spirit in the north to ask for inspiration, wisdom and power. You turn to your Council of Spirit Guardians; you call them in and most importantly of all, you sit in council with them and you listen to them. You talk with them about your life and death prayer arrows and ask them to give you the wisdom to choose wisely what you are ready to discard and what you are ready to manifest into your life and in the world.

This is very much what my Joshua Tree on the Mesa Gathering, “Soaring On the Wings of Intent,” is all about this year. It is what our entire 2007 year of online courses on dreaming, “Dreaming the Tapestry of Your Life,” is about. The Great Dreamer God that has been dreaming us for eons, carrying our dreams in his hands, is beginning to awaken. This means that we are moving into a time of awakening, when each of us learn to carry our own dreams in our own hands. It is the time of the Waking Dreamer, a time to awaken to your own inner power to determine your life path.

Great Spirit, as you empower the flowers to the brightness of spring color, I honor my long winter of introspection and bring forth my new beginnings. Mother Earth, I plant my love, my seeds, from the sacred gourd of plenty into your gracious land. I listen for the language of the drums, the symbols of the sacred shields, to enlighten me.
